To help, region and world-service money is available to pay delegate expenses, including the expense of a live interpreter.


To apply, complete the <u>Delegate Support Fund application</u> and send it to your OA region by October 1, 2022, or by the date specified in your region's bylaws. After a region review, qualified applicants will need to send their applications to the World Service Office by November 1, 2022.

It is critical for OA's worldwide group conscience that we include as many delegate voices as possible at WSBC. If your service body needs assistance, we encourage you to apply.

The option to contribute to the Delegate Support Fund was paused for the years that WSBC was made virtual, but you will soon be able to contribute once again to this fund. Look for an upcoming announcement and check back at <u>oa.org/contribute</u> for the "Delegate Support Fund" option to appear in the Designation drop-down menu and on our <u>mail-in contribution form</u>.



## Digital Files in Translation List Updated Plus More Translation News

If you are wondering whether an OA literature item has been translated, look to the Digital Files in Translation list, which is appended to the <u>Guidelines for</u> <u>Translation of OA Materials PDF</u>. The World Service Office updates this list quarterly, and it contains all licensed OA-literature translations for which the WSO has a digital copy.

Translation funds are available whether you are a registered group or service body or "a small group of interested OA members" who do not yet have an OA service body. Recently, Junccab NSB in Brazil received funding to translate the Business Conferenc Policy Manual and OA, Inc. Bylaws, and your group can receive funding too. To apply for funding, complete the <u>Translation Assistance Fund application</u> and return it by the February 1, 2023, deadline.
